

# How To Configure SAS Servers Script into Bootstrap (UNIX)

---

## Generate bootstrap server startup and shutdown commands

- `su - root`
- Execute `$(SASCONFIG)/Lev1/ generate_boot_scripts.sh`
- `cp sas.servers` (output of `generate_boot_scripts.sh`) to `/etc/init.d`

## To add sas.servers to bootstrap

To install this script, as user "root", invoke:

- `/sbin/chkconfig --add sas.servers`
- `/sbin/chkconfig --level 35 sas.servers on`

The "--add" (the double-dash is correct) tells `chkconfig` to add this boot service type to the system. The "--level 35" with the "on" tells `chkconfig` to arrange for this service to start at run levels 3 and 5.

## To verify that the installation succeeded, invoke:

```
/sbin/chkconfig --list sas.servers
```

This should show which run levels the `sas.servers` script will start under.

## To remove the script from all runlevels, as user "root", invoke:

```
/sbin/chkconfig --del sas.servers
```
