

How to Stop Using HTTP when HTTPS is Configured for Use

After deploying SAS middle tier via SAS Deployment Wizard using https with Secure Socket Layer option (SSL/TLS) the ports associated with the http protocol are still open and available. In order to close these ports or to direct all traffic towards https secured ports, additional steps are required.

Note: SAS 9.4 M2 (Maintenance two) these steps are automatically done during configuration step.

For SAS 9.4 M0-M1 do the following:

1. Navigate to the httpd.conf file of your SASServer1_1 located at
<../config>/Lev1/Web/WebServer/conf/
Location example:
/dev/opt/sas/6.2/config/Lev1/Web/WebServer/conf
2. Comment out the line:
Listen <port#> to #Listen <port#>
